Speaker : Prof Edward Ng

Prof Edward Ng is an Architect, as well as a Professor at the Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK). He has practiced as an architect as well as lectured in various universities around the world. His specialty is in Environmental Design. He is Director of the M.Sc. Sustainable and Environmental Design Programme at CUHK. He is also the founding chairman of Wu Zhi Qiao (bridge to China) charitable foundation. As a visiting professor of Xian Jiaotong University, China, he has designed ecological schools and sustainable projects in North West China. Among many other prestigious awards, he has twice won the RIBA International Awards.

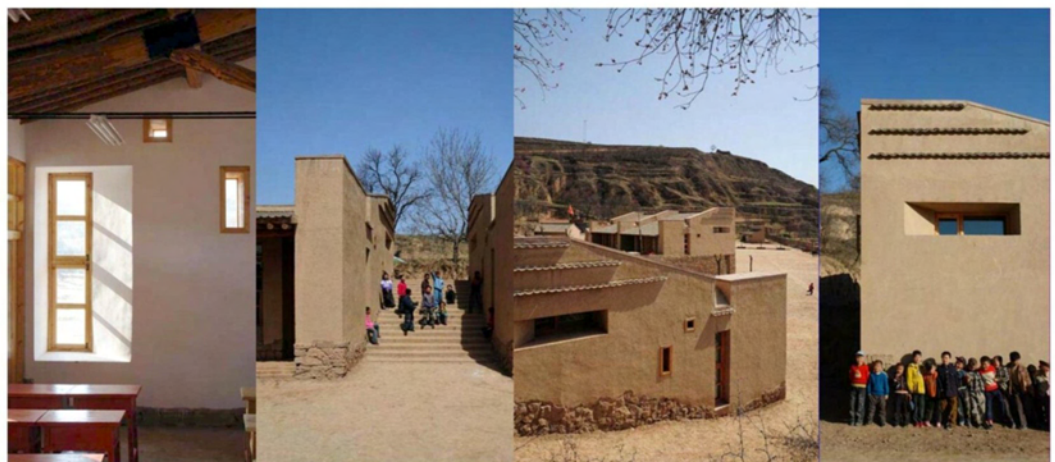
Synopsis :

Many village villages have been built, many of them with donations from Hong Kong sponsors. However, some of the 3 storey concrete and brick buildings located in the loess regions of North West China can only be described as "unbearably hot in the summer and extremely cold in the winter". They are inappropriate and a waste of resources and energy. Since 2003, Edward has embarked on the journey of finding a sustainable way to deal with the problem. The result is the award winning Maosi Eco-school in Gansu, China. He will talk about his journey walked.
